At the end of the course the participants are expected to be able to:
identify the main idea and choose the appropriate grammatical unit in accordance with temporal and cause-effect relations, realized in the particular situation of communication, and the structure of the text on the whole.

Course Objectives and Content:

The objective of the course „Grammar for professional purposes” is to develop grammatical competence, allowing students to communicate in the most common situations of daily and professional life at A2 level of language proficiency according to “The Common European Framework of Reference for Languages.” By the end of the course, grammatical skills at A2 level of language proficiency according to “The Common European Framework of Reference for Language” are developed. Students are familiar with the selected aspects of German Grammar (morphology and syntax) and are able to apply the theory studied to practice.
