Learning objectives:

The objective of the course “English Grammar” is to develop grammatical competence, allowing students to communicate in the situations of daily and professional life at B1 level of language proficiency according to “The Common European Framework of Reference for Languages.”

By the end of the course, grammatical skills at B1 level of language proficiency according to “The Common European Framework of Reference for Language” are developed. As a result, students are able to identify the main idea and choose the appropriate grammatical unit in accordance with temporal and cause-effect relations, realized in the particular situation of communication, and the structure of the text on the whole. In general, students are expected to become more conscious of advanced grammar structures, and hence be able to apply them in their spoken and written language production.
