Lecture. Seminar. The constitutional reform of 1993 and the state policy and management in the Russian Federation. The adoption of the Constitution in 1993 and the characteristics of the constitutional order of Russia.

Section 3. The nature and types of state policy in modern Russia.

Lecture. Seminar. The uniform state policy. Reforming the economy. Financial and monetary policies. State scientific and industrial policy. Agricultural policy. Social politics. Minimum social security, state social standards. The subsistence minimum consumer basket and poverty level. Social protection: types and forms. The social insurance system. State regulation of the labor market. The legal framework of the state policy in the sphere of labor and employment. The state family policy. State youth policy.

Section 4. Electoral system of modern Russia.

Lecture. Seminar. The role of elections in the political development of modern Russia. The party system in modern Russia.

Section 5. Management and self-management in the Russian Federation.

Lecture. Seminar. Public authorities of the Russian Federation. The functions of local government.

The principles of organization of local self-government in the Russian Federation. The composition and functions of local government.

Municipal authorities and the social sphere. Institutions of social protection in the municipality. The mechanism of the development of the social policy of the municipality. The basic tendencies of development of local self-government in Russia.

5. Organization and methodological support of independent work of students

5.1. Types and forms of self-study

Independent work of students includes the current and creative problem-oriented independent work (TCP).

Current CPC aims to deepen and consolidate students' knowledge, practical skills development and includes:

7. Quality rating development disciplines (modules)

Assessment of quality of mastering the discipline during the current and interim assessment of students is carried out in accordance with the «Guidance on the current control of progress, intermediate and final attestation of students of Tomsk Polytechnic University», approved by order of the rector № 77 / 29.11.2011 of the odes of

In accordance with the «Schedule of study of discipline»:

current certification (quality assessment of assimilation of theoretical material) and the results of practical work (performance of tasks) is done during the semester (measured in points (maximum 60 points), by the end of the semester the student must score at least 33 points);

intermediate certification (offset) is produced at the end of the semester (measured in points (maximum 40 points), to offset the student must score at least 22 points).

The final rating for the discipline is determined by summing the scores obtained in the course of the current and intermediate certifications. Maximum overall rating corresponds to 100 points.
