

Review presentation against the following:

1. Slide content

Presentation

- has a title, agenda, and speaker contact info
- has a purpose and objectives of the study
- has a problem and significance statement
- provides information on the methods for conducting a research
- provides an overview of the sources used in the study

Content of presentation is informative, up-to-date, well-structured and organized.

2. Slide format

- a similar format/background for all slides within presentation
- slide readability
- slide backgrounds (*not too dark and too bright*)
- slide color (*bright orange and reds “play tricks” with eyes, and red/green conflicts*)
- the information is short and to the point (*not more than eight lines per slide*)
