1. Slide content

Presentation

has a title, agenda, and speaker contact info

has a purpose and objectives of the study

has a problem and significance statement

provides information on the methods for conducting a research

provides an overview of the sources used in the study

Content of presentation is informative, up-to-date, well-structured and organized.

2. Slide format

a similar format/background for all slides within presentation slide readability slide backgrounds (not too dark and too bright) slide color (bright orange and reds "play tricks" with eyes, and red/green conflicts) the information is short and to the point (not more than eight lines per slide)
