



Things to Know about the IPB

Key features:

How to Apply to the IPB

• **Application Deadlines:** IPB - Fall Semester, Campus Mosbach: 31 May

IPB - Spring Semester, Campus Mosbach: 30 September

IPB - Spring Semester, Campus Bad Mergentheim: 30 November

- Admission Process:
 - Application materials submitted by the deadline will be given first consideration in the participant selection process.
 - Qualified applicants will be admitted to the program / campus of their choice as space allows.
 - Rolling admission after deadlines have passed: Applications received after the deadline will still be considered. However if all slots have been filled, they will be placed on a waiting list and notified if space becomes available.



Costs

• For exchange students, the estimated minimum monthly expenses are approximately 750 €.

This includes

-	Housing (per month) plus refundable safety	250.00 € to 400.00 €
	deposit of two to three months in most cases

- Public health insurance (per month – for non-EU citizens) 77.90 €
