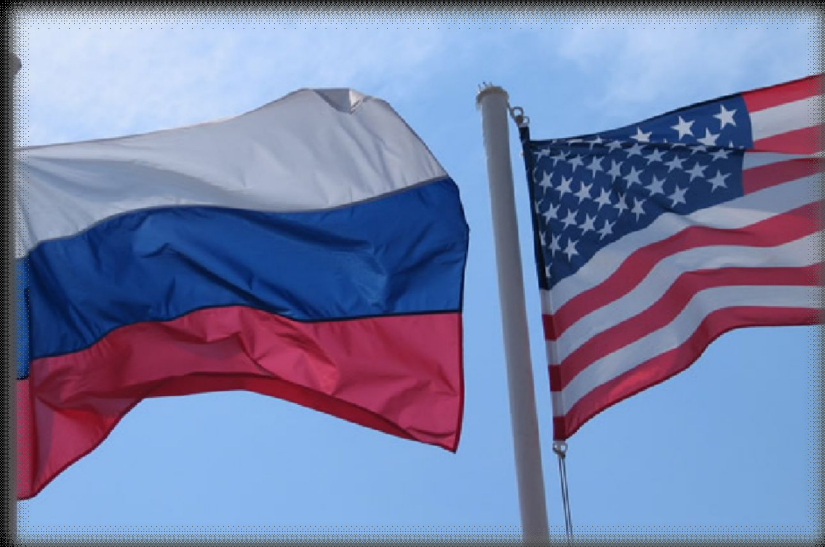




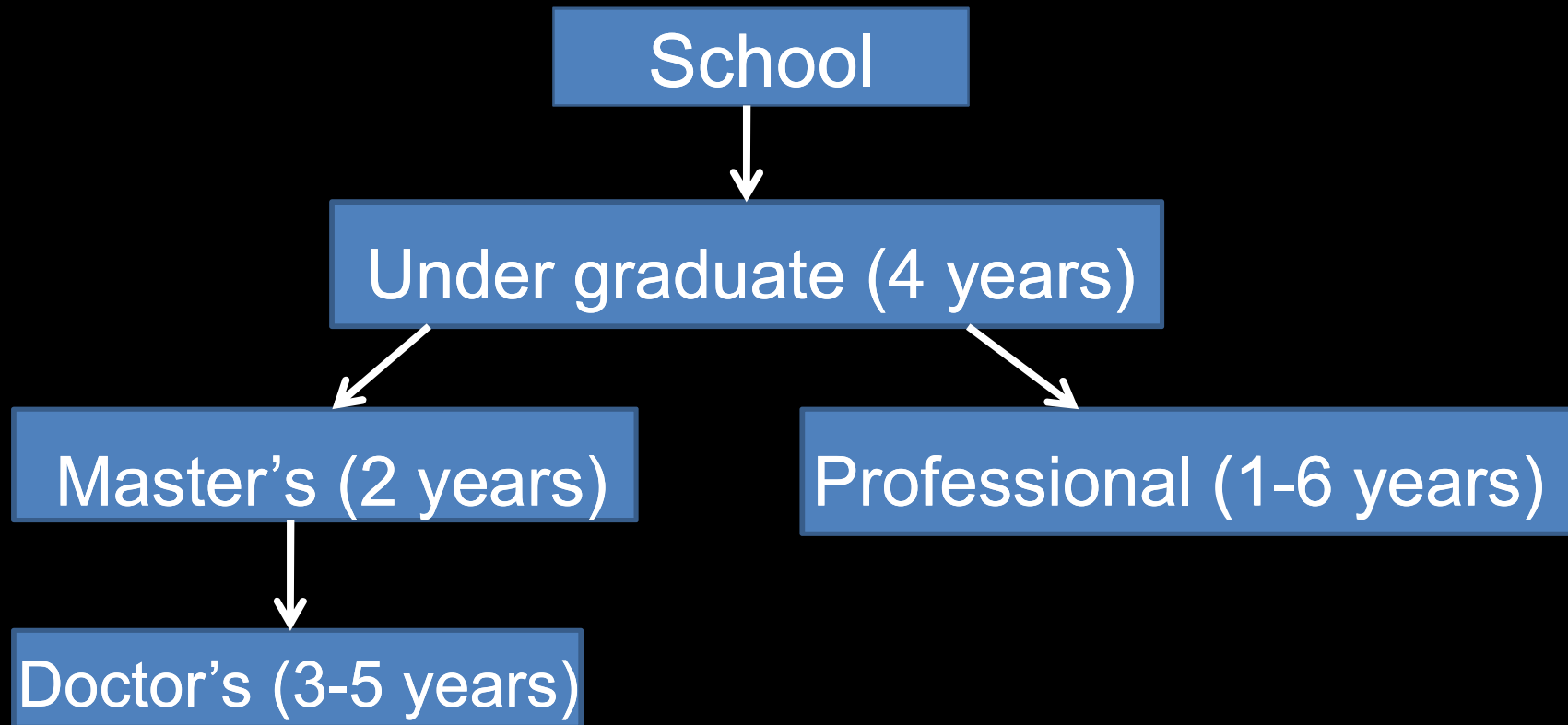

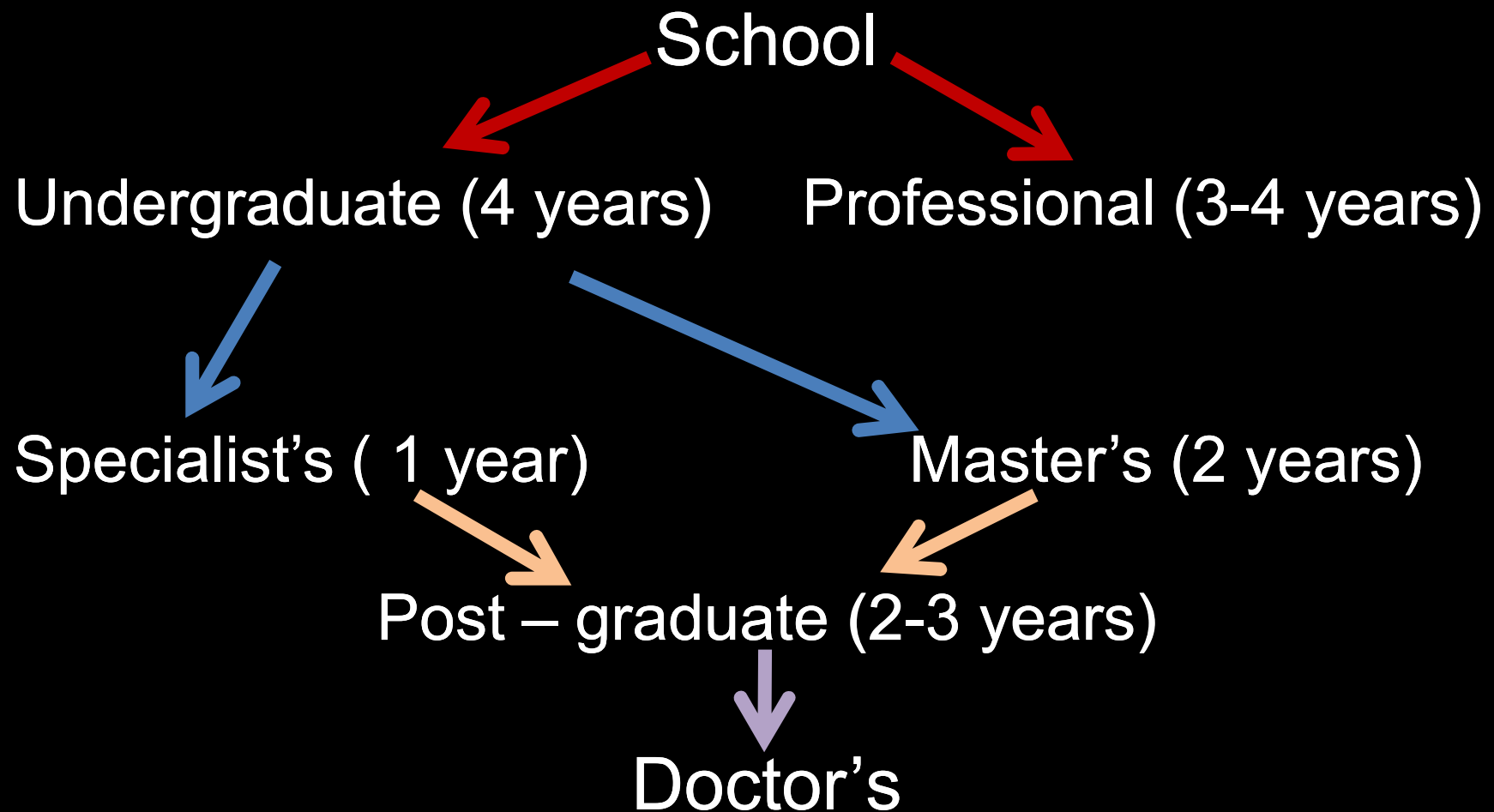

# The proportion of people with higher education in the population aged 25-64 years



USA – 30 %

Russia – 21 %

# Number of students in higher education

The amount of students in Russia and in the USA is practically the same. Still, if we consider the population of these countries, we will see that the percentage of people studying in Russian Universities is a bit higher .

USA – 13, 2 million people = 4, 4 % population

Russia – 6, 9 million people = 4, 8 % population

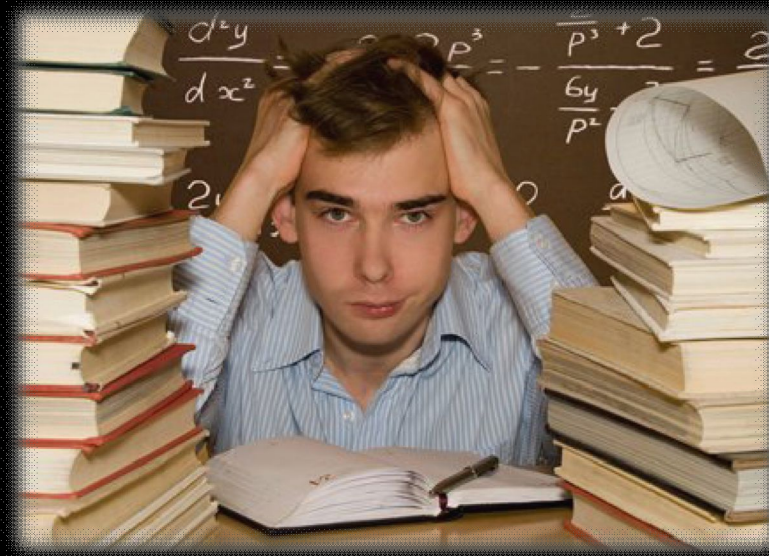
