ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

All submitted abstracts should be in one of the working languages of the conference (English, German and French)

File format: MS Word. File title must contain the last name and the initials of the author. (Smith J. K.)

The margins: left – 1.8 cm. top, bottoms – 2.6 cm.

Abstract font: Use 10-point Times New Roman throughout. Text should be single spaced.

Title: center justification, no indentation, no hyphenation.

Title text: lower case, bold face.

Author's last, first name, patronymic and affiliations: lower case, regular font.

Text body: full justification, paragraph – 0.5 cm, use hyphenation.

One line space between title and authors, as well as between affiliations and abstract text.

References are given after the text body.

At the end of the text abstracts titles, author's name and affiliation in English must be given.

The amount of pages is unlimited. No figures, tables, diagrams or references should be included.

By the end of the conference all the abstracts will be included in conference proceedings available online.
