

FELLOWSHIPS FOR RUSSIAN STUDENTS

The Honorary Consulate of the Russian Federation in Lausanne offers two fellowships for outstanding Russian students to undertake Masters studies at the École Polytechnique Fédérale de Lausanne (EPFL). Financial support of CHF 16'000 per academic year will be offered for two years, starting in the academic year 2012/13.





Who can apply?

Any student with an **excellent academic record** holding a Bachelors (or equivalent) degree from a reputed Russian university can apply. Good language skills in the teaching language of the chosen Masters Programme (i.e. English and/or French) are a prerequisite (minimum level C1).

How to apply?

The candidates have to apply online for a specific EPFL Masters Programme. During the online application, candidates have to indicate that they are applying for an EPFL fellowship and they have to specify in their motivation letter that they are candidates for the "Russian Consulate Fellowship".

When to apply?

The online application process is open from beginning of November 2011 to January 15th, 2012 and from mid-February to April 15th, 2012. We strongly recommend applying for the January deadline!
