REQUIREMENTS TO CONFERENCE

PROCEEDINGS

Articles should be submitted to the organizing committee not later than on **30th March 2016** in *Microsoft Word* text editor in *doc* file for *Windows*. Font **Times New Roman**, size - **12**; interval - **1**; left and top margin - **30 mm**, right and bottom margin -**25 mm**; submission e-mail: <u>MKKorovin@vandex.ru</u>

Maximum report size is 2 full A4 pages.

Avoid hyphenation. Figures and tables should not occupy more than one A4 page. Place figures within the Word Document with the help of Microsoft Word tools "Insert a picture" and "Text box" (to mark figures).

Preferred files for: for graphs and charts - **EPS**, **TIFF** (uncompressed) or **JPG**, resolution - **150 dpi**, maximum format A4 size; for photos - **GIF**, gray scale. References in the text should be presented in square brackets specifying the number of reference. Example: [1]. Place references one space from the article body. References should be in alphabetical order according to the authors.

ARTICLE STRUCTURE

Paper title (Arial 10 in bold capital letters in the centre), next line -interval 1, Initials and last name of the author (Arial 12 low-case); next line - interval 1,5 (Arial 10 bold italic) - Position, initials and last name of the scientific advisor: next line - interval 1,5 (Arial 9 bold italic) - full name of the institution, city, country; next line -interval 1,5 text of the paper. Avoid abbreviations.

E-mail your article and application form to: <u>MKKorovin@vandex.ru</u>. The file should be named according to the following format: number of panel, author's surname and type of document (For example: 5_Ivanov_application form; or 5_Ivanov_article).

The article should be signed both by the author and the scientific advisor.

In case when the article doesn't meet the above mentioned requirements, it will not be published.

Participation in the Symposium is free. Publications will follow. Conference materials will be published as a Book of proceedings by the beginning of the Conference. The best report competition will be held in frames of XIX Russian scientific conference of young scientists. The best articles will be published in "Environmental Earth Science" journal indexed by SCOPUS.
