


Are our teachers ready for change?


- 2012 Benchmarking report by Cambridge English Language Assessment

- Issue 7: Absence of lesson reviews



Figure 2 Mean performance by test task (by Chair-group)





12 teachers had a 2 week course in Cambridge 36 teachers got a CELTA certificate










Interaction patterns in the classroom






The use of Russian in the classroom




The use of Russian in the classroom (Teachers' responses %)
